Dear Parents, Students, Teachers, and Building Occupants,

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requiring schools to inspect and identify any asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM). LCA hired a certified building inspector to identify and sample any suspect asbestos-containing building materials.

The law further requires the school to have an asbestos management plan. LCA has an asbestos management plan available for review online at our website and in the school administrative office during regular business hours. Kelly Davidson is our designated asbestos program coordinator, and all inquiries regarding the asbestos plan and asbestos-related issues should be directed Kelly Davidson at kdavidson@lca-co.com

Updates for the year:

Our designated staff surveys the condition of the materials every six months and the condition of the material remains in good condition. This year we hired DS Environmental Consulting, a certified building inspector, to re-inspect the ACBM for our required three year re-inspection.
